CRRUA Now 96.5% Compliant in Correcting Deficiencies Identified by NMED

The Camino Real Regional Utility Authority (CRRUA) has now corrected 56 of 58 deficiencies identified by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) in its 2023 Sanitary Survey of CRRUA and is 96.5% compliant. CRRUA provides water and wastewater services to Sunland Park and Santa Teresa, NM.

CRRUA initiated a Progress Checklist to track the corrections. The latest deficiency CRRUA corrected is number 38 on the checklist, which is repair of the level indicator at the airport water storage tank. The two remaining deficiencies on the checklist are numbers 41 and 50.

“This improved performance indicator is positive news for CRRUA customers,” said CRRUA Executive Director Juan Crosby. “They benefit from all the upgrades we’ve initiated over the past year and a half since I assumed operational control of the system in the way of water that meets state and federal drinking water standards. It represents our continued progress in helping improve the health and welfare of our community.”
