### CRRUA Passes August Arsenic Tests

The Camino Real Regional Utility Authority (CRRUA) passed its voluntary monthly arsenic tests for August 2024.

Test results released by Eurofins Environment Testing, a water testing lab certified by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED,) show that arsenic levels at three of the four arsenic treatment facilities (ATF) operated by CRRUA are below the federal limit of 10 parts per billion (ppb.)

The Sunland Park ATF was operating with one of two filter media chambers offline for [filter media replacement](#) when the water samples were taken on August 21, 2024.

CRRUA excluded the Border Entry ATF from its voluntary monthly testing due to its continued meeting of all NMED requirements.
