

CRRUA Passes March 2025 Arsenic Tests

The Camino Real Regional Utility Authority (CRRUA) passed its voluntary monthly arsenic tests for March 2025, as verified by an independent laboratory. CRRUA provides water and wastewater services to Sunland Park and Santa Teresa, NM.

Test results released by Eurofins Environment Testing; a water lab certified by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED,) show the Sunland Park Arsenic Treatment Facility (ATF) at 1.7 parts per billion (ppb,) Santa Teresa Community ATF at 6.3 ppb and Santa Teresa Industrial ATF at 7.3 ppb. The test results are from samples taken March 20, 2025. All three were below the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Maximum Contaminate Level (MCL) for arsenic of 10 ppb.

CRRUA excluded the Border Entry ATF from its voluntary testing due to its continued meeting of federal and state requirements.

As of January 2025, all four Arsenic Treatment Facilities (ATFs) operated by CRRUA are NMED compliant, which means they are below EPA's MCL for four consecutive quarters.

So far this year, CRRUA passed NMED's first quarter arsenic test, and three-monthly voluntary tests as verified by an independent laboratory. In 2024, CRRUA passed 18 arsenic tests including three quarterly NMED tests.
