

Happening Now: A water well that was offline for repair is back in service resulting in discolored water temporarily in the Bluffs and Valencia Park subdivisions. When a well returns to service, the water flow disturbs naturally occurring sediments in distribution lines that results in discolored water. The Sunland Park Fire Department is helping to minimize the amount of time the water will appear discolored by flushing fire hydrants in the impacted areas. Although the water is safe to consume, CRRUA recommends waiting for it to clear before washing laundry. The discoloration should disappear within 24 hours.
